## The International Move: TEN TO-DO'S FOR THE KIDS

- 8) Favorite Places: Plan a few final visits to favorite venues.
- 9) Careful Sorting: Don't throw our old toys which can help ease the transition by providing a sense of continuity.
- 10) Garage Sale: Let the children help and earn money they can exchange for their new country's currency.

The kids that tend to have it the hardest are those that are going through big changes already like puberty or school changes, especially middle-school age kids. The best thing for parents to do is support each other and work hard to make the move as positive as possible.
